The time we all look forward to has finally arrived. It's time to enjoy our beautiful lake. Club Owned Sunfish - Did you know we



are the only yacht club on the lake that has club owned and maintained sailboats available for members' use. All our Sunfish are well cared for and in good condition. Contact me if if you have questions or concerns about the Sunfish, want to reserve use of a boat(not required but recommended for special events), need help rigging a boat, or need instruction for sailing.

Summer sailing - As summer moves along, it gets a little warm and some folks say it's too hot to sail. Have you considered these ways to enjoy sailing? **Sail a Sunfish** - Free board is just a few inches. You gets lots of water spray. If you want to drop over the side for a dip, reboarding is easy. Pack a lunch and sail to the island. Play in the water and sail back. **Anchor your boat** - Take your

boat out to a sheltered cove, anchor, and use your boat as a swim platform. When you get your boat out on the lake, the natural a/c turns on. Anchored in a gentle breeze is awesome. **Go for an evening sail** - Around 7:00 pm, the evening breeze generally fills in and the temperature is much cooler. **Sail by the Light of the Silvery Moon** - Plan to sail on a full moon or near full moon night. No operating running lights on your boat? Easy fix. Academy, Bass Pro Shop, West Marine all sell battery operated red/green and white navigation lights.


